Reversible Runner

A minimum of 2 patterns will be presented, each will require approximately **2x sets of fabrics – 4x fat quarters of each will be fine** – in colours/prints that contrast with each other, **plus a fat quarter (or more) fabric to use for binding**. There may be time in class to complete one runner and start a second.

As the title of the class suggests you will be working with the front and back of the project at the same time, so you will find it easier if you have one set of fabric choices for the front and a completely different set of choices for the back. You might, for instance, have a selection of pale blues for the front and a selection of rich purples and reds for the back.....or autumn shades for the front and Christmas prints for the back.

There will be a selection of fat quarters available to buy on the day.

You will also need **1/2yd or metre of needlepunched all-cotton batting** (Warm & Natural, Warm & White are two brand names to look for). It is important that the batting is cotton because you will be pressing with a hot iron – polyester will melt. We will have suitable wadding available for purchase on the day.

- Sewing machine in good working order, new needle plus spare
- Cotton sewing thread of your choice in a neutral colour
- **Cotton sewing thread to tone with one of your colour choices**
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat – please check your blade before class and replace with new if required
- A few pins
- Fabric scissors
- Fabric marker of your choice
- Pencil
- Scissors for snipping threads
- Travel iron and pressing pad - optional
- Extension cable - optional
- Cushion(s) for your comfort
- Your lunch
