Bag Day

We will be offering several new bag patterns on the day – featuring zips, pockets galore, embellishment, plus a dinky coin purse with zip – you may even get them all finished! We will have some batting and zips available for your use according to your choices and there will also be a basket of fat quarters.

Requirements

- 7" zip, black or neutral
- Zip foot for your machine
- Walking foot for your machine
- Spare needles – we would suggest including a jeans needle as well
- A variety of threads – some of your stitching will be visible, and you may even get to use some of the fancy stitches on your machine.....
- Ric-rac, buttons and general twiddly bits if you have them – if yours don't work with your fabric choices then they may help someone else
- 2 D rings and 2 swivel clips - 1 inch size (optional, but potentially useful)
- Fabric scraps, chunks and bits, fat quarters etc. Also, jelly roll leftovers might be useful
- If you hanker after a co-ordinated look, then 1metre of each of 3 go-together-but-different fabrics will not go amiss.
- Plus you will need fabric for lining bags – so chuck in another 1m of something just in case (you may well have fabric left over but its far better to have too much on the day ...)

Plus the usual list, which is -

- Sewing machine in good working order, 2 pre-wound bobbins, a new needle and spares, handbook and all accessories
- Cotton sewing thread of your choice in a neutral colour eg dark cream, pale grey
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat – please check your blade before class and replace with new if required
- A few pins
- Fabric scissors
- Fabric markers of your choice
- Scissors for snipping threads
- Travel iron and pressing pad - optional
- Extension cable - optional
- Cushion(s) for your comfort
- Your lunch

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
