Turning on the Charm

Take a Charm Pack; stitch it together, cut it apart, turn it around etc (all the usual 'messaging about' you'd expect from a Chris and Barbara workshop) until you produce a small wall hanging / bag front / cushion front / or whatever you fancy turning it into.

Requirements

A charm pack (or two), or the equivalent in cut squares (about forty 5inch squares, with as few repeats as possible)

Plus the usual list, which is -

- Sewing machine in good working order, 2 pre-wound bobbins, a new needle and spares, handbook and all accessories
- Cotton sewing thread of your choice in a neutral colour eg dark cream, pale grey
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat – please check your blade before class and replace with new if required
- A few pins
- Fabric scissors
- Fabric markers of your choice
- Scissors for snipping threads
- Travel iron and pressing pad – optional (PAT certificate required)
- Extension cable – optional (PAT certificate required)
- Cushion(s) for your comfort
- Your lunch
