Grow your Own Quilt Top

We will be making a pieced frame (medallion) style quilt top based on a 19th century quilt. You can make this top as intricate or plain as you wish – with a limited palette or with scraps. Minimum size is 44", although you could very easily let it grow into a larger size.

Please bring:

Fabrics

- as an absolute minimum about **1m of a main fabric**
- **plus at least 4 light and 4 dark fat quarters (prints or plains)** to go with the main fabric/print.

For a scrap/less controlled look you will need strips varying in width from 1½ inches up to 6½ and in length from 12 inches to 45 for the various borders.

If in doubt, bring lots of fabrics you like and we'll go from there!

We will have a basket of fat quarters available for purchase and general drooling.

- Usual sewing kit
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat plus a spare blade
- Your sewing machine & spare needles, handbook, foot pedal etc
- Notebook and pencil for quilting ideas
- Your lunch
- A cushion for your comfort – the chairs can feel a bit low and hard after a couple of hours.
